We've had the privilege of reading many expressions like these over the years. They appear on surveys, arrive in the mailbox – even pop up on the computer and phone. And they made 2017 – our 35th anniversary year – something worth celebrating.

The Annual Report for 2017 gives you an idea why. Across our 35-year history:

- More than 7,600 children experienced Summer Camp.
- Another 2,700 families participated in Family Camp.
- Nearly 6,000 children took part in our hospital-based Sunshine 2U program.
- College became a little more affordable for 167 teens who received scholarships.
- Generous individuals and organizations donated more than \$40 million.

Even looking back over 35 magical years, 2017 was one to remember. We provided 154 programs delivered over 177 days during the year, welcoming families from all over Georgia – and beyond.

And we tracked, measured and evaluated. We completed a research study exploring the experiences of nurses volunteering at summer camp; collaborated with Emory University's School of Nursing to assess physical activity and fatigue in pediatric oncology patients; and conducted a comprehensive parent survey to evaluate our programs and guide future planning.

This annual report documents the highlights and metrics of another successful year. However, we could not have done it without the countless people who volunteer their time and support our efforts. As one family put it:

"Our family has no idea how we could have made it through these difficult years without Camp Sunshine! Camp Sunshine staff and volunteers are our second family. We have grown to care about all of you as much as you have cared and supported us. Thank you!"




